She is a graduate of the Yale University School of Medicine and a psychiatrist at Harvard University. The general address will be presented by Cary McQueen, founder and executive director of Art With Impact, an organization that seeks to help eliminate the stigma of mental illness by sharing the stories of individuals through short films and other works of art.
