## The Collaborative Assessment & Management of Suicidality (CAMS)

### What is CAMS?

***CAMS is an evidenced-based treatment framework used to assess suicidality and specifically treat suicide risk.*** CAMS 3-part training provides mental health professionals with essential knowledge in using the CAMS framework to collaborate with patients in the treatment of their suicidal drivers.

**6 published correlational studies & an RCT support the effectiveness of CAMS in reducing patients' suicidal drivers.**

### What Does CAMS Training Include?

#### **CAMS' 3-part training includes:**

1) **A 3-4 hour, self-paced online course:** This course features a series of videos which provide an overview of the CAMS model. Completion of the online course is required prior to in-person, role-play workshop.

2) **An in-person, 1 day workshop:** David Jobes, Ph. D., ABPP, Professor of Psychology and Associate Director of Clinical Training at The Catholic University of America, will train participants in using the CAMS framework through role-play where participants take turns acting as both counselors and patients. Dr. Jobes is the developer of the CAMS framework.

3) **Group consultation calls:** Following the workshop, group phone calls will be held for 8 weeks, providing opportunity to discuss successes and challenges as participants implement the CAMS model.

***Upon completion of role-play workshop, participants will receive 10 CEUs.*** The OhioMHAS Continuing Education Committee is an approved provider of Continuing Education Units (CEUs) for RNs, LPNs, Ohio Counselors, Marriage & Family Therapists, Social Workers, Chemical Dependency Professionals, and Psychologists.
