What it is like to Lose Someone to Suicide: Promoting Hope and Resilience in Suicide Loss Survivors

Presenter: Rebecca Prather, MSW, LISW-S

Suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death for college students and the 10th leading cause of death in the U.S. On average there are 130 deaths by suicide per day, and nearly 1,900 Ohioans die by suicide each year. In this one-hour presentation, participants will gain general knowledge on how suicide impacts others and beginning steps to assist suicide loss survivors. Participants will also gain knowledge on 1) How losing someone to suicide impacts loved ones 2) Define "normal" reactions to suicide 4) Define Post-traumatic Growth 5) Determine how to assist suicide loss survivors. In addition, participants will gain awareness on Postvention being Prevention. Rebecca Prather is a Licensed Independent Social Worker with Supervision designation. Rebecca has presented on various topics, including a panel discussion for continuing education credits geared toward how to implement Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy to clients in poverty, Violence in Schools, and Self-Care for Professionals. She has been closely involved with the National Association of Social Workers Ohio Chapter, serving as a Regional Director on the Board of Directors since 2019. Rebecca also serves as a Co Vice-Chair of the Summit County Suicide Prevention Coalition.
