Poster presentations should be related to promoting student safety & well-being, mental health awareness and campus suicide prevention efforts. We are particularly interested in highlighting the efforts of organizations including institutions of higher education, nonprofit and/or our student-led groups.

Poster abstracts should clearly specify the core ideology, context of the research, model or practice, and audience in which it is designed for. Poster submissions should also include a title, a description for review (500-word limit) and an abstract (200-word limit) for the conference program. Incomplete and insufficient proposals will not be accepted.
