Shuherk, also a nonfiction book reviewer and influencer, is known on social media under the username @schizophrenicreads. His broad reach with 167K TikTok followers and 137K Instagram followers gained Shuherk accolades as one of Men's Health Magazine's Top 60 Influencers Worth Following in 2023.
