The Ohio Program for Campus Safety and Mental Health is offering an opportunity to become a QPR Instructor for a limited number of campus-community members. The intention of this QPR Instructor course is to equip members of Ohio's campus-community with suicide prevention knowledge and skills specifically for pre-professional and professional students. Students enrolled in professional and pre-professional programs such as medicine, dentistry, veterinarian medicine, pharmacy, and law, are exposed to unique stressors that can often lead to supports and referrals for mental, emotional and behavioral needs. Approximately 45 to 75% of individuals who die by suicide have seen a primary care provider within a month before their death and also a significant percentage of people who die by suicide or experience suicidal ideation have contact with a healthcare provider according to researchers. As a QPR Instructor, you will have the ability to instruct others to become QPR Gatekeepers and help prevent suicide at Ohio's institutions of higher education. Additionally, as a member of this exclusive cohort, you will become a member of a QPR community of practice.
